Did you know your benefits change when you turn 21?

SoonerSelect covers individuals from birth to age 20 as a “child”. At age 21, the individual is considered an adult and their coverage will transition to adult dental benefits. Read below to learn how to maximize your dental benefits before you age out.



Children Under 21

- Preventive (dental cleanings and fluoride)
- Restorative (silver and tooth-colored fillings)
- Full and partial dentures
- Extractions
- Root canals
- Crowns
- Braces and Othodontia

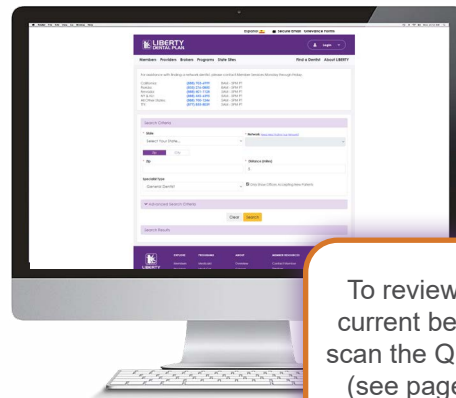
Adults 21 and Over

Beyond Benefit Program:

LIBERTY offers members who are aging out of child benefits extra supports including access to case management services and extended coverage of all necessary dental services under a federal provision called Early Periodic Screening and Diagnostic Treatment (EPSDT) services. Case management is a service where a nurse or care coordinator help you to overcome barriers to dental services such as helping to schedule transportation or other supports. All covered services are available for 45 days after “aging out” of child benefits (if a youth enrolls in Adult Medicaid dental benefits, it will exclude covered benefits).
