

RE: OPPOSITION TO ELIMINATE LOS ANGELES COUNTY "PHP" DMC PROGRAM

Dear State Representative:

I am writing, as a local dentist, in opposition to a provision in the recently proposed FY 2020-21 State Budget. I strongly urge you, as my County Supervisor/State Legislator/State Senator, to join me in actively opposing this provision which would eliminate the Denti-Cal Managed Care (DMC) Program in Los Angeles County.

I have been in practice in Los Angeles for 27 years, am a member of the LADS and have been a part of LIBERTY Dental Plan (LIBERTY) for more than 7 years in General and Specialty practice for adults, children, and families in the LA PHP program.

I am proud of the work I am doing for my patients in partnership with LIBERTY. We work closely together to help ensure the needs of my patients are met.
